RESOLUTION 11 - 2006

**A RESOLUTION RE-ENACTING, RATIFYING, AND REIMPOSING THE TAXES,
AND SETTING THE TAX RATES, FOR HOPEWELL TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE YEAR 2007, AND APPOINTING THE PENNSYLVANIA
DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AS ITS AGENT FOR CERTAIN TAXES**

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Hopewell Township, York County, Pennsylvania, does hereby adopt a Resolution re-enacting, ratifying, and reimposing for the year 2007 without substantial change the following taxes which were in effect in the year 2006, except for those taxes repealed in Section 6:

SECTION 1: The Ordinance adopted April 5, 1965, imposing a tax upon the transfer of title to real estate located within Hopewell Township at the rate of one-half of one per cent (0.5%) of the fair market value of the property being transferred. This tax is hereby re-enacted, ratified, and reimposed pursuant to the Local Tax Enabling Act and the Tax Reform Code of 1971, as amended, 72 P.S. §8101-D et seq. The Pennsylvania Department of Revenue is further appointed as the Township's agent to determine on the Township's behalf any additional local real estate transfer taxes that may be due, to collect all such additional taxes, together with interest and costs, and to charge the Township the collection fee authorized by the Local Tax Enabling Act.

SECTION 2: The Ordinance enacted June 1, 1968, imposing a tax of one-half of one per cent (0.5%) upon the earned income of residents of Hopewell Township and upon the net proceeds derived from the operation of any business or other activities by residents of Hopewell Township and a tax of one-half of one per cent (0.5%) upon the income earned by non-residents of Hopewell Township within Hopewell Township and a tax of one-half of one per cent (0.5%) on the net proceeds derived from any business or other activities conducted in Hopewell Township by non-residents, with credits being granted to non-residents in the amount of tax paid to the local government of such person's residence on account of income earned in Hopewell Township.

SECTION 3: The Ordinances re-adopted on December 23, 1976, and amended on December 1, 1977, imposing a tax of seven (7) mills on the dollar of the total amount of assessed valuation of all real estate and improvements thereon located within the confines of Hopewell Township, except that the rate of said tax has been reduced to twenty-one one-hundredths (0.00021) of a mil (two and one-tenth cents (2.1¢) per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation, for a multiplication factor of .00021).

SECTION 4: The Ordinance No. 9-2005, adopted December 1, 2005 imposing an Emergency and Municipal Services Tax on every person employed in the Township, as amended by Ordinance No. 2-2006, which tax shall be increased to and set at the amount of \$42.00, pursuant to Section 9 of Ordinance No. 9-2005; EXCEPT THAT any person whose total income from all sources, whether within or outside the Township, is less than \$12,000.00 in any calendar year is exempt from this tax.

SECTION 5: To the full extent required and permitted by law, all of the above taxes are hereby re-enacted, ratified, and reimposed.


SECTION 6: The tax imposing a per capita tax of five (\$5.00) dollars per annum upon each resident or inhabitant of Hopewell Township over eighteen (18) years of age, adopted by Ordinance enacted March 26, 1963, as amended by ordinances on December 21, 1972, December 23, 1976, December 7, 1978, and by Ordinance Nos. 11-2002 and 1-2003, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: This Resolution shall be effective January 1, 2007.




